RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives appropriations bill, which funds the Departments of Transportation, Treasury and Housing and Urban Development, Judiciary, and District of Columbia did not move the administration of the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) from the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) to the Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, the Senate appropriations bill for the Department of Justice also rejected the transfer of the HIDTA program from ONDCP to the Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, the National District Attorneys Association believes that the HIDTA program should remain in the Office of National Drug Control Policy; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the National District Attorneys Association hereby supports the current legislative position that the HIDTA program should remain in the Office of Drug Control Policy.
